12:30pm~1:30pm Spanish Level I

Level 1 Spanish covers introductory Spanish vocabulary for students. Each lesson is based on a specific theme and contains a group of numbers to continue practicing counting in Spanish. New vocabulary will be introduced throughout the semester with each new lesson. Lessons will cover:

- Introduction to alphabet
- Greetings
- Colors
- Numbers 1-10
- Parts of the body
- Shapes
- Fruits and vegetables
- Animals
- Classroom objects and school supplies
- Family
- Weather
- Seasons
- Months of the year
- Days of the week
- Likes and dislikes

1:30pm~2:30pm Spanish Level II

Prerequisite – Spanish Level I

Level 2 Spanish is a continuation of Level 1 and covers introductory Spanish vocabulary for students. Each lesson is based on a specific theme and contains a group of numbers to continue practicing counting in Spanish. New vocabulary will be introduced throughout the semester with each new lesson. Lessons will cover:

- Greetings
- Asking and answering personal questions about where you are from, family, and favorite things.
- Describing people and things using adjectives
- Morning routines
- Feelings and emotions
- Describing ability using “can”
- Subject pronouns (I, you, he, she, we, they) to describe different people’s feelings and abilities
- Describing places in your town
- Prepositions of location
- Present continuous tense to describe activities you are doing now
- Past tense activities
- Time frequency – how often?

2:30pm~3:30pm Adult Spanish Level I

Adults seeking to learn Spanish will receive an introduction to the language and proper use of vocabulary and verbs. New vocabulary will be introduced throughout the course. Beginner conversational skills will be practiced throughout the semester. Lessons include:

- The alphabet and proper pronunciation
- Greetings and mini dialogues
- Cognates
- The Noun
- Subject pronouns
- Verb to be
- Verb to like
- Present tense of regular verbs and irregular verbs
- Demonstrative and possessive adjectives
- The personal "a"
- Direct and indirect object pronouns
- Past tense

3:30pm~4:30pm Adult Spanish Level II

Prerequisite – Adult Spanish Level I

Adults seeking to improve their Spanish skills will continue to practice the language and proper use of vocabulary and verbs. New vocabulary will be introduced throughout the course. Conversational skills, as well as reading and writing skills will be practiced throughout the semester. Lessons include:

- Review topics from Spanish level I
- Future tense
- Synonyms
- Idiomatic expressions with prepositions
- Adjectives and comparisons
- The progressive tenses
- Uses of prepositions a, en, de, con
- Verbs that require a preposition
- Perfect tenses
- Expressions with haber, hacer
- Expressions with dar
