In this class, students will learn fundamentals of grammar that are the building blocks of the English language, and then use their skills to be better editors. Through repetition of practice, students will thoroughly learn the concepts and why they are important, not just learn many things they can't remember or use later. By the day end of the class, students will know the parts of speech, types of sentences, and proper use of punctuation, and also be better at seeing grammar errors in their own work. This class conforms to the grammar rules used in standardized tests like STAAR, ACT and SAT.
